

## HEALTH PROFESSIONS Standardized National Code Structure and Commonly Known Job Titles

The following health occupations are coded using the 2000 U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL), Bureau of Labor Statistics Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) System. The SOC is used by Federal statistical agencies to classify workers into occupational categories for the purpose of collecting, calculating, or disseminating data. Some SOC codes and titles will be revised effective 2010. The additional job titles included in each coded category were provided by the Occupational Information Network (O\*NET). O\*NET is sponsored by the USDOL's Employment and Training Administration and is the nation's primary source of online occupational information. OSHPD will provide updates to this listing as changes are identified.
